I am an Idaho Power customer and the owner of a 4 kw solar system that I installed in 2015. I log the energy output of my system and, using IPCo rates, calculate my energy cost savings and system payback. Under Idaho Power's net metering my system has a rate of return of about 6%, or about 16 year return on investment. Obviously I didn't install the system because of massive dollar savings, rather I installed my solar system because everyone has to do their part to reduce carbon emissions and help to save our planet for our children and grandchildren. I urge IPUC to reject any rate design proposals from Idaho Power that would discourage the growth of customer solar generation.
