On June 19, 2020, Idaho Power Company ("Idaho Power" or "Company") applied for authority to remove the two-meter requirement for new Schedule 84 customers and to grandfather existing customers with two-meter systems under the current 1:1 monthly netting for 10 years.

On July 17, 2020, the Commission issued a Notice of Application and Notice of Intervention Deadline. Order No. 34728.

On August 10, 2020, the Commission issued an Amended Notice of Application. Order No. 34746.

Now, the Commission issues a Notice of Telephonic Public Hearing and Notice of Modified Procedure setting comment deadlines.
