On October 8, 2020, Rocky Mountain Power, a division of PacifiCorp (the "Company") requested authority to increase the wind and solar integration rate applicable to new power purchase agreements ("PPA") between the Company and wind and solar qualifying facilities ("QFs").

On November 23, 2020, the Commission issued a Notice of Application and Notice of Intervention Deadline. Order No. 34840. On December 16, 2020, the Commission issued a Notice of Parties.

The Commission now issues this Notice of Modified Procedure and sets deadlines for interested persons to comment on the Application, and for the Company to reply.

The Commission notes that Modified Procedure and written comments have proven to be an effective means for obtaining public input and participation.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that persons desiring to state a position on this Application may file a written comment explaining why the person supports or opposes the Application. Persons who would like a hearing must specifically request a hearing in their written comments. Persons shall have until February 12, 2021, to file written comments.
