Dear Commissioners,

I am writing to you regarding the proposed rate increase for Idaho customers of Avista Utilities. I moved to Winchester in mid 1994, at that time electrical service was provided by Washington Water Power. In late 1999 Washington Water Power was purchased by Avista Utilities. For the past 16 years I have kept a careful record of my electrical usage.

Beginning in 1995, I began to make improvements in my home toward reducing my consumption of electrical power. These improvements included insulation, insulated doors, insulated windows, storm doors, and energy saving appliances. These improvements have allowed me to reduce my electrical energy consumption by 8%

Since Avista has been supplying electrical power, a ten-year period from the year 1999 through 2009, the cost of my electrical energy has increased 74.5%. I cannot believe that Avista's cost of doing business has risen to that degree.

I am attaching a copy of one of my spread sheets documenting my electrical consumption and costs over the last 15 years. I also have a spread sheet that shows electrical consumption and costs by the month for the same period if you are interested.

I am retired, and as I am sure you are aware, I will not receive any cost of living increase this year nor next year, thanks to a Congress that gave themselves a \$5,000.00 a year raise. I could not determine the salary of Avista's top management this year, but a couple of years ago it was posted on the web and the CEO was receiving more than five million dollars a year. If Avista needs more operating funds, I suggest they look inward. They keep asking their customers to reduce their electrical consumption and they keep asking Utility Commissions to allow them higher rates. Why?

For these reasons I am asking you, the Idaho Public Utilities Commission, to deny any rate increase for Avista Utilities. And I am going on record as opposed to any increase for Avista. I know the Commission must look at both sides of any issue and that your job is to protect the public and the utility companies. But please keep in mind that the public never comes before you asking for a rate reduction of any utility company. We just do our best to reduce our consumption and costs as we are able.
