Eastern Idaho Railroad, L.L.C. – Abandonment Exemption –
In Bonneville County, Idaho

Dear Sir/Madam:

On or about February 24, 2020, Eastern Idaho Railroad, L.L.C. ("EIRR") intends to file with the Surface Transportation Board, Washington, D.C., a notice of exemption under 49 C.F.R. Part 1152, Subpart F – *Exempt Abandonments and Discontinuances of Service and Trackage Rights*, to permit the abandonment of an approximately 0.76-mile segment of a railroad located in Idaho Falls, Bonneville County, Idaho, extending from milepost 184.14 (immediately southeast of the grade crossing with Yellowstone Highway), to milepost 184.90 (north of the grade crossing with W. Broadway Street) (the "Line"). The Line traverses United States Postal Service ZIP Code 83402. The proceeding will be docketed as STB Docket No. AB-1252 (Sub-No. 1X). A map depicting the Line is enclosed herewith.

This notice letter supersedes one previously sent to you under the incorrect docket number AB-1252 (Sub-No. 2X), which letter also understated the length of the Line to be abandoned. The correct docket sub-number is Sub-No. 1X, and the full scope of the Line is as provided in the previous paragraph.

The exemption procedures set forth at § 1152.50 will be invoked because no local traffic has moved over the Line for at least two years, and overhead traffic (if any) can be diverted to other routes. Based on information in our possession, the Line does not contain federally-granted rights-of-way. Any documentation in the railroad's possession regarding federally-granted right-of-way will be made available promptly to those requesting it.
